ABOUT THE VIRTUAL OPEN HOUSE

This open house is designed to share key results and takeways from the draft Community Area Plans (CAPs) with the public. Each station around this room will guide you through the main components of the plans and allow you to preview some of the mapping assessments and recommendations for addressing local challenges and needs.

While this open house provides a summary of what's in the draft CAP plans, each plan in its entirety can be reviewed in detail and commented on at **CAPdraftplans.com**.

USER GUIDE

The virtual open house has automatically placed you at the Welcome Station (#1). From here, you can navigate to other stations around the room by using the dropdown menu in the top righthand corner of the screen or you can pan around the virtual space (click, hold, and drag) and click on one of the blinking arrows on the floor pointing you to a nearby station.

At each station, you will find a series of props, including poster boards, tv screens, tablets, or tables with a large map or several documents. Click on a prop to view the information in a pop-up window (for small documents on a table, you will click on the blue icon hovering above the table). Once you're done viewing the content, click on the "x" in the upper righthand corner of the pop up to close it.
